

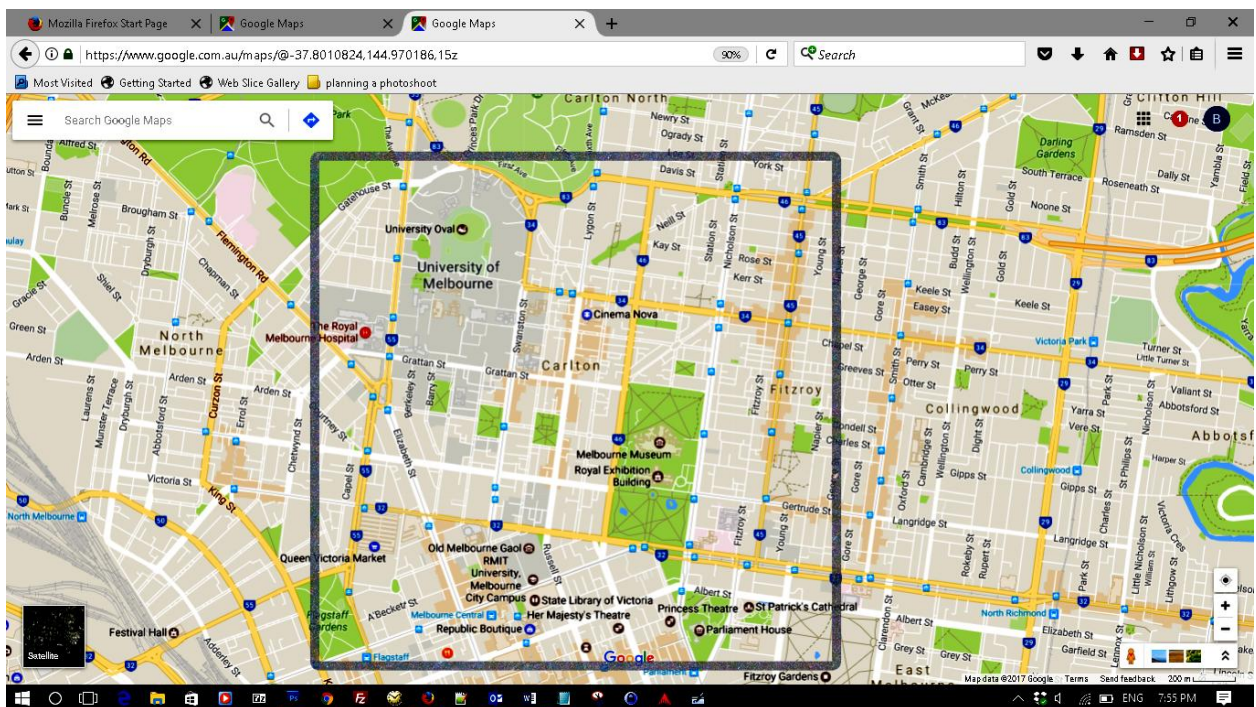
#### Melbourne City Walk : Melbourne University Underground Carpark
